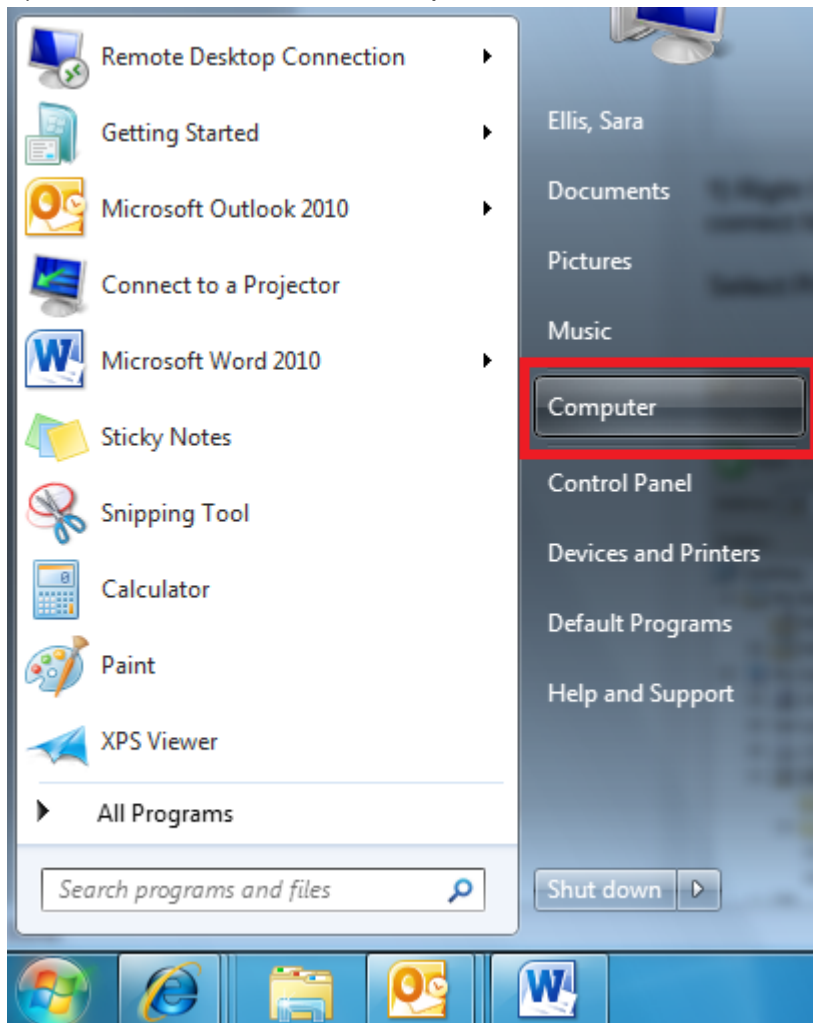


## How do I map my S or U Drive?

1) Go to Start and select Computer



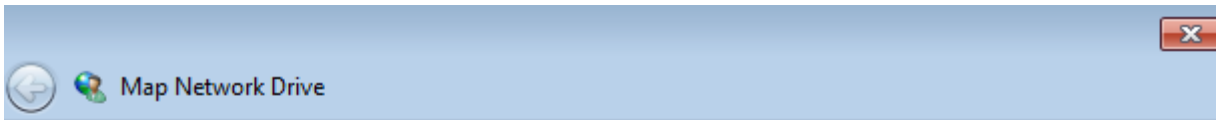
2) Select Map network drive

3) The 'Map Network Drive' wizard will appear. In the 'Map Network Drive' wizard, select the relevant Drive letter (either U or S)

4) Next, for the Folder enter the server location (see below):

a) For ICT Managed U drives enter [\\fiona\myfiles\YourUNumber](#) (e.g. [\\fiona\myfiles\u0012345](#)).

b) For the S drive enter [\\windows\dfs\common](#)

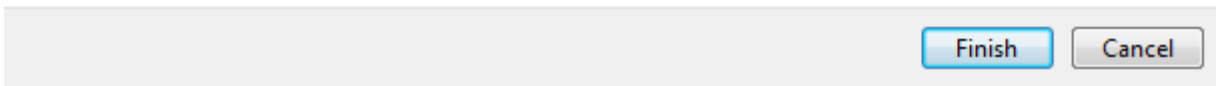
